## Itinerary for Sangha Japan Trip July 9–24, 2001

11 <sup>th</sup> Wednesday	Walk	Nanzen-ji plus big walking day, get to know area. Philosophers walk, beginning with Nanzen-ji, and sub temples, each with a temple fee: Nanzen-in, Tenjuan, Konchi-in. Then Eikan-do, Zenrin-ji, Honen-in, ending with (Ginkaku-ji) or the (Kyoto Handcraft Center) and then a long walk home on the philosopher's walk or through all the shops in Gion district.
12 <sup>th</sup> Thursday	Tour Bus	Ryoan-ji. Lunch at Ryoanji then by bus to, Daisen-in and Daitokuji, Myoshinji.
13 <sup>th</sup> Friday	Tour Bus	Koryu-ji, then Tenryu-ji (Kozanji, Jingoji) or Katsura Rikyu (if we are able to go as a group).
14 <sup>th</sup> Saturday	Walk	Sanjusangendo, National Museum, (Kyoto Craft Center, gardens at Chishakuin see two famous Edo paintings: Cherry tree, sakura-zu and maple tree, Kaede-zu) and Shorenin, then Kenninji and its gardens. 2-3 miles all around. Also if time, Kawai Kanjiro Memorial Hall exhibit of famous 20th century potter. Anyone who wants to can walk to Kyomizudera on the way home. Lots of shops and restaurants.
15 <sup>th</sup> Sunday	Tour Bus	Nara: Bus to take us to several different areas, Horyu-ji and Chugu-in. Then Toshodai-ji, Yakushi-ji, (Hokkeji, Saidaiji).
16 <sup>th</sup> Monday	Tour Bus	Nara: Long day, much walking. Bus to drop us at one place and pick us up there at end of afternoon. Kofuku-ji, Nara Museum, other museum, Todaiji, Daibutsuden, Shoso-in (and, if time, Shinyakudaiji).
17 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday		FREE DAY
18 <sup>th</sup> Wednesday	JR Pass	<b>Obama</b> ( <b>Bukkokuji</b> , <b>Tangen Roshi</b> ). Long day, leave early return on Thursday, the 19 <sup>th</sup> .
20 <sup>th</sup> Friday	Tour Bus	<b>Sanzen-in</b> and <b>Enryakuji</b> . Long day. Sanzen-in: early so there is enough time to get lunch and stop at Enryaku- ji (Tendai) at Mt Hiei. <b>Shukakuji</b> (or Shugakuin) is less crowded and has lovely gardens. Will be a tight schedule, big day, we should leave early.
21 <sup>st</sup> Saturday	Bus?	OPTIONAL FREE DAY or Toji Temple antique fair. Next (Kosho-ji and Sosen-ji). Walk to Tofuku-ji or Sennyuji, Imakumano-kannonji and the gardens at Chishaku-in. Big walking day.
22 <sup>nd</sup> Sunday	JR Pass	Kamakura. Long day.
23 <sup>rd</sup> Monday	Tour Bus	Several different stops with bus. <b>Byodoin</b> and <b>Mampuku-</b> <b>ji</b> . <b>Daigoji</b> and gardens at <b>Kanjuji</b> . This will not be as long a trip as the two days in Nara. It should be an easier day.
24 <sup>th</sup> Tuesday	JR Pass	To Osaka and Canada.
